If someone else's drinking is impacting your life, know this: you are not alone. Al-Anon is a safe and compassionate community for anyone who has been affected by another person's alcohol use—whether it's a spouse, parent, child, sibling, or friend. Many of us carry silent burdens, trying to hold things together while feeling overwhelmed, isolated, or unsure of where to turn. Al-Anon offers a place to be heard, to find understanding, and to begin healing with the support of others who truly understand what you're going through.

Al-Anon meetings are held every Monday and Tuesday at 6:00 PM in Room 211 of the Family Life Center (FLC). These weekly gatherings provide strength, encouragement, and practical tools to help you find peace—regardless of whether your loved one is still drinking or even seeking help.

For teens who are walking a similar path, Alateen offers a space just for them. It's a supportive group where young people can connect with others their age who understand the struggles that come from being close to someone with a drinking problem. Alateen meets Mondays at 6:00 PM in Room 211 (FLC) and offers hope, connection, and a reminder that they're not alone either.



THE VINE | AN ADULT BIBLE STUDY


You're Invited to The Vine! | Tuesdays | 6:00 PM | Room 215 in the FLC




